Olympias and Agricultural Boys End Game with Fisticuffs.

The Olympia Athletic Club football elevon of this city forfeited to Maryland Agricultural College at College Park, Md., yesterday afternoon by the score of 6 to 0.

The game was marked by very unpleasant features by the visitors. The game began with Maryland kicking behind Olympia's goal line. Olympia kicked out from the 25-yard line and Duganne brought the ball back 10 yards. After advancing it on three trys, Maryland was held on downs, and Olympia carried the ball back to the middle of the field. Kennedy kicked the ball around Maryland's left end and was tackled, but continued to crawl with the ball. Brown fell on him. Kennedy jumped up and struck Brown twice, Brown returning the blows. Referee Markey put both men off the field. The Olympias then refused to continue the game on account of Kennedy not being able to play. After leaving the field they reconsidered their decision and returned to the game. The Olympias carried the ball down the field by end runs, and finally forced Hoover over for a teuchdown. Hoover kicked an easy goal.

Time for the first half was then called.

In the second half Hoover kicked to Maryland's 25-yard line and Watts ran the ball back 15 yards. Maryland, by splendid work, forced the ball rapidly to Olympia's 30-yard line, when the incident that ended the game occurred. On an end iun Watts blocked Thompson, Olympia's right end. Thompson then struck Watts three times. He was promptly ejected from the game by Referee Markey, and at the refusal of Capt. Evans to continue the game Referee Markey forfeited the game to Maryland Agricultural College,

to 0. The action of Referee Markey was strongly approved by the college authorities.
